Elective Rounds

Purpose: Cover entire paediatric orthopaedic curriculum on rotating basis.

Trauma Rounds

Purpose: Cover entire paediatric trauma curriculum on rotating basis and to allow fellows opportunity to develop teaching skills.

Spine Rounds

Purpose: Preoperative presentation, planning and discussion for all spine cases in advance of OR.

Morbidity and Mortality Rounds

Purpose: Discuss and record recent events leading to morbidity and mortality for quality improvement.

Outcomes Rounds

Purpose: Detailed subspecialty case discussion with significant outcomes and literature review – lead by fellows.

Teams: Bouchard/Kelley; Camp/Narayanan; Howard/Murnaghan; Hopyan/Guest of Hopyan!

Each Staff Surgeon Team moderates 1x per 2 months. Respective fellow collects 2 interesting cases for presentation (with outcomes). Fellows also prepare supplementary literature review on topic to support case.

Research Rounds

Purpose: Facilitate fellows to have presentable project for U of T Ortho Fellow Research Day in May, and submission for publication by end of fellowship in July.

Teams: Supervising Staff surgeons, with research coordinators.
